Tour Description

First, travelers will be greeted at the dock, where the cruise ship docks, where they will be met by private vehicles and private English speaking guides, where they will go on a brief city tour of Manaus, including the market, historic center and Opera House (entrance fee included). Next, they will be directed to the port, where they will board fast boats (as opposed to the slower regional boats) and be taken to a floating restaurant for lunch, located in Lago do January, across the Rio Negro from Manaus. After lunch, they will, once again, board the boats and pass by the meeting of the waters to observe the meeting of the waters phenomenon, where the Rio Negro and Solimões Rivers flow side by side but don't mix, then navigate through a floating ribeirinho community called Lago do Catalã, before stopping at the community pier to fish for, Pirarucu - the largest freshwater fish in the world. Next, returning to the boats, they will navigate to an indigenous community, where they will have the chance to spot pink dolphins and be welcomed with a traditional indigenous dance and presentation by the community. At the end of the afternoon, they will return to the floating restaurant, to finish the day with a cocktail while enjoying the incredible sunset that only the Amazon is capable of providing. For those who want to, they can follow the guide through a short, light trek through the forest to observe Amazon species, such as the largest tree in the Amazon, the Samaúma, and Victoria Régias (this last activity requires a very low fitness level)
